

CALL FOR ARTISTS:

Guidelines for the Ventura County Government Center's Outdoor Sculpture

Revised: August 29, 2009

Location: Ventura County Government Center, 800 S. Victoria Avenue, Ventura, California, the outside courtyard, in between the Hall of Administration and the Hall of Justice Buildings, to the right of the Hall of Administration Building entrance, in front of the Bus stop at Victoria Ave and Thille St. Interested parties please review pedestal.

Pedestal size and Mounting: The pedestal is 39" above ground. The top of the pedestal is 49" x 49" square. There are four cross tracks to hold the sculpture in place with bolts. Each cross track is 20" long.

Installation & Removal: Crane price is \$145/hr with a 2hr. minimum (\$190) for installation or removal, crane provided by Harry Waycasey, phone: (805) 649 - 1115. The Artist must provide their own transportation for their Sculpture.

Suggested Minimum Height: 20 feet

Insurance: The Artist is responsible for insuring their sculpture. VCAC has liability insurance.

Liability factors: This site has the potential to receive large gusts of wind.

Duration: Mounted at this location for approximately one year (VCAC is flexible with the duration)

Evening Lighting: Lighting is now minimally offered

History: Built and designed in 1991 by artist Bill McEwen and later collaborating with artist Paul Lindhard.

Artist & Donor Acknowledgement: VCAC will provide; a reception, postcards, a press release sent to Ventura County media outlets, and eMail Blast. A plaque frame (16" x 9") can be provided for recognition of donors funding the cost of installation and transport to the site. Donor must supply plaque to fit frame.
